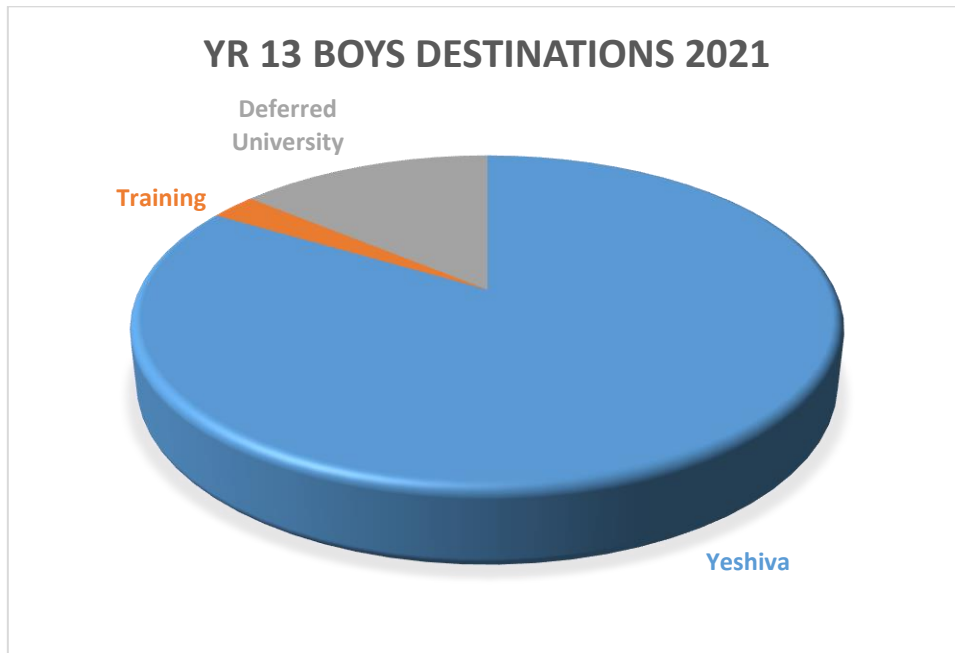


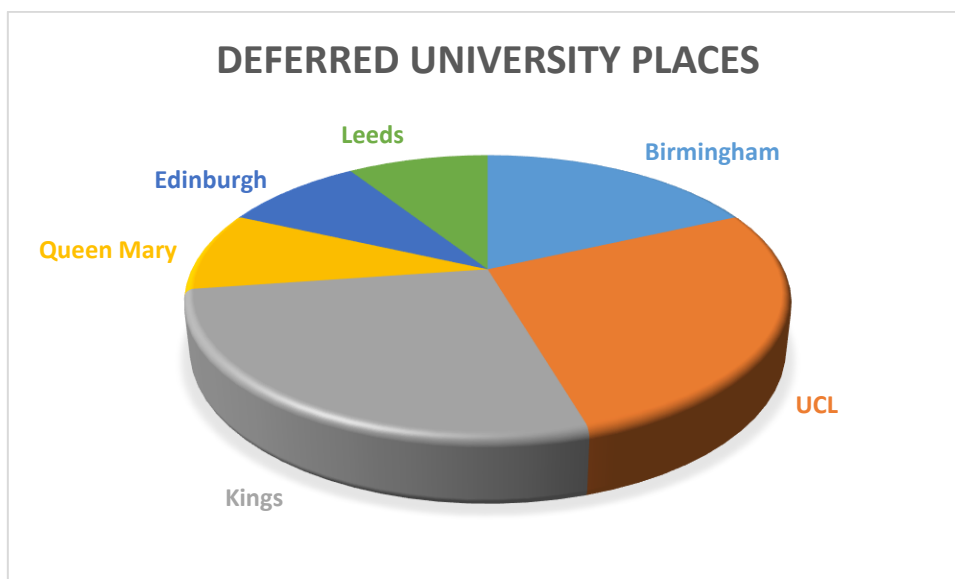
Year 13 Destinations (2021)

BOYS DESTINATIONS

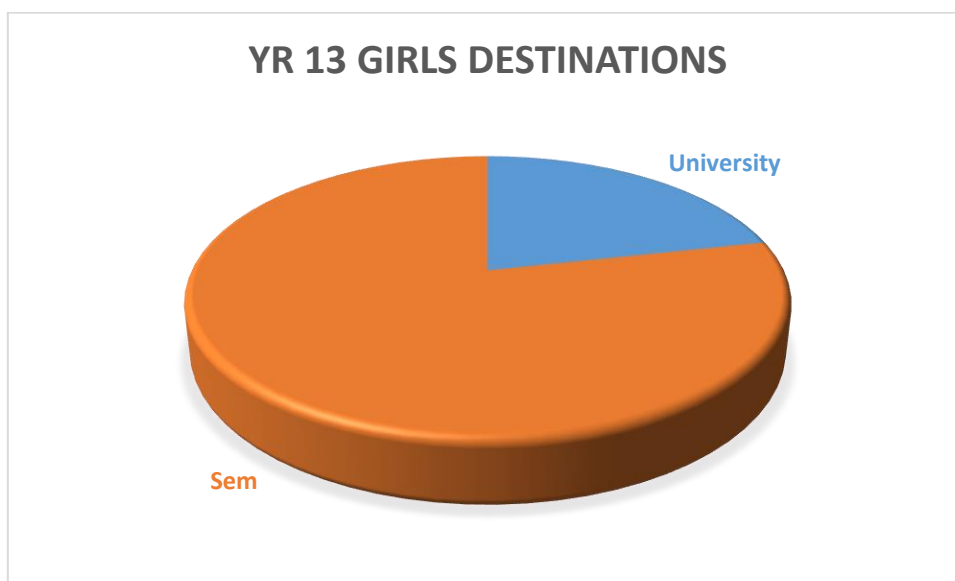


The vast majority of Yr 13 boys went on to Yeshiva for their gap year. Two students attended training at the BEAM Academy and the MDA Paramedic Training.

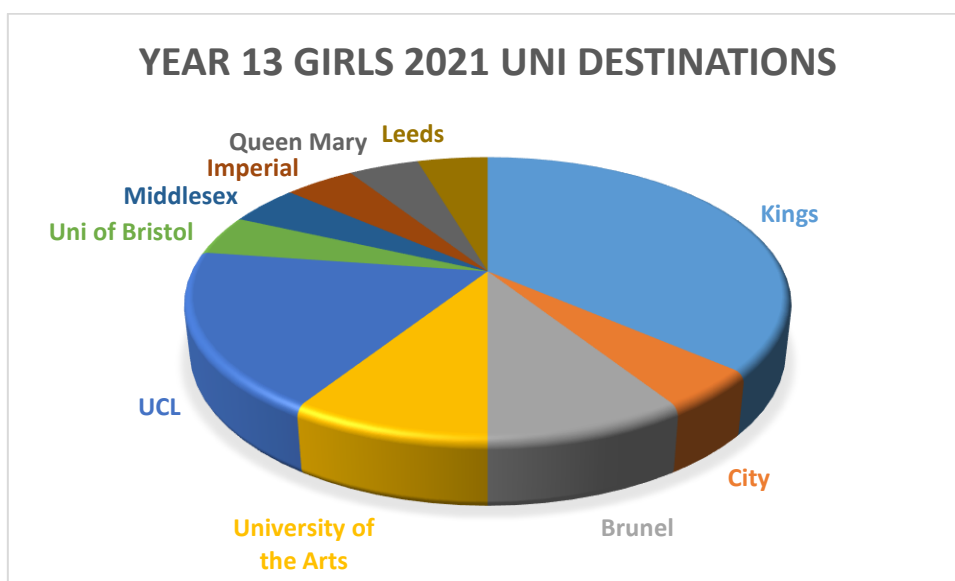

GIRLS DESTINATIONS



More girls than boys in the 2021 cohort went on to University than a gap year/Sem, with 78% of girls attending Sem and 22% opting to go to university.



Many girls have been accepted at Kings College London. The courses read included: Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy and Nursing as healthcare options. Other courses include: Biomedical sciences several times and Maths, interior design and English, Psychology, Economics and Ancient Languages.
