

Hasmonean High School – Admission Appeals 2023

Secondary Transfer:

Offers will be made by your Local Authority on behalf of Hasmonean through the coordinated admission scheme on **1st March 2023**.

If your application for a place is not successful you have a right of appeal to an Independent Appeals Panel.

Appeals will be dealt with as follows:

Your appeal, together with any supporting paperwork, must be submitted in writing to the Clerk to the Admission Appeals Panel, c/o Hasmonean High School, Holders Hill Road, Hendon, London NW4 1NA by **Thursday 11th May 2023**.

Appeals will be held **during the week commencing 19th June 2023**.

You will be given at least 10 school days' written notice of the appeal hearing, unless you waive this right. At that time you will be given another deadline for submitting any additional written evidence. Any information received after that deadline may not be considered.

In-Year Admissions:

If your application is unsuccessful you have a right to appeal. You will be given at least 20 school days from the date of notification that your application was unsuccessful to prepare and lodge your written appeal.

You will be given at least 10 school days' written notice of the appeal hearing, unless you waive this right. At that time you will be given another deadline for submitting any additional written evidence. Any information received after that deadline may not be considered.

Sixth Form Appeals:

Sixth Form appeals will not be held before confirmation of examination results on which the offer of a place depends.

You will be given at least 10 school days' written notice of the appeal hearing, unless you waive this right.
