HOW DO I CHOOSE MY WORK EXPERIENCE?

Students are expected to find an employer

DISCUSS WITH TUTORS, SCHOOL STAFF,
RELATIVES AND FRIENDS

Most places are found locally but the larger employers have the best work placements (you can go on site visits, attend board meetings, visit different departments where you work)



WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

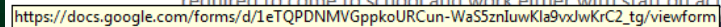



Choosing a Placement

Try to choose an employer that is local or work with your parents .

Ask the employer what you would like to learn/do – reject a placement if you think you will just be making tea/photocopying.

Choose an employer that will be of interest to you or linked to your favourite school subject

Choose an employer within the school ethos





Although only for one day, try to choose a larger employer - smaller employers have less time to train you and less opportunities to learn from different employees/departments of the business.

ORGANISATION CHOICE & CONFIRM IT –
YOU CAN GO ON THE WEBSITE TO
CHECK THE IF PLACEMENT IS
CONFIRMED



FINAL POINTS.....

1.YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING FOR TRAVELLING COSTS

2.DON'T GO SOMEWHERE JUST BECAUSE A FRIEND IS GOING THERE

3.DO NOT EXPECT TO BE PAID FOR THE WORK – THOUGH SOME PUPILS DO



4. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO GO ON A PLACEMENT WITHOUT SCHOOL CONSENT.

5. ONCE A PLACEMENT HAS BEEN ORGANISED TRY NOT TO CHANGE IT – COMPLETE A NEW ONLINE FORM IF YOU DO.
